

At Star School, we believe that student dress code should be based on a few simple, easy to follow principles. While choice of clothing is a very personal matter, appropriate clothing for school should also be clean, safe, modest, and not cause a disruption of school. Clothing that carries messages that are sexually suggestive, or that has vulgar or abusive language or that promotes alcohol, tobacco, drugs or weapons is not proper dress. Bare midriffs, short shorts, clothes with gang messages, hanging chains, flip flops and low slung pants are not viewed as appropriate.

If the Teacher believes a dress code problem exists, a conference will be held with the parents. If the issue is not resolved, it may be appealed to the administrator for solution or if not satisfied with the administrator's solution the parents can appeal to the Board for the final solution.
